INTRODUCTION

The Mount Zion Hospital records were donated by the hospital in 1992 and additional materials were received in early 2000. Processing was done by at least two archivists over a period of years and was completed in 2000 by Julia Bazar with the assistance of Eda Regan and Eileen Adams. Intern Laura Hollander assisted with the photographs.

HISTORY

Mount Zion Hospital Association was founded in 1887 "for the purpose of aiding the indigent sick without regard to race or creed, to be supported by the Jewish community." It opened its first hospital ten years later in 1897 and functioned as a private non-profit institution until its merger with UCSF in 1992. A subsequent merger of UCSF with Stanford Hospital was dissolved in 1999. During this period Mount Zion was more fully integrated into UCSF, closed its Emergency Room and ceased being a Jewish hospital.

The Mount Zion Hospital Association was formed by a group of 43 prominent members of the San Francisco Jewish community on November 3, 1887 at the home of Frederick and Charlotte Castle. On November 5th the first Articles of Incorporation were adopted and on November 9th Board of Directors were chosen with Frederick Levy Castle as the first President of the Board serving until 1893. (Mrs. Castle was appointed Honorary President of the Ladies' Guild after its formation in 1897). The constitution and by-laws were approved at a meeting of the patrons and members of the association in December 1888. Over the next nine years funds were sought to enable the building of a hospital. Donations came from local residents, New York and Europe, but went slowly since the community was divided on the need for a specifically Jewish hospital and on whether such a hospital should then serve only Jewish patients.

The first hospital opened in 1897 at Hyde and Sutter in a building that had been offered with a free year's rent by Dr. Julius Rosenstirn who served as Chief of Staff and Chief of

Surgery. A Polyclinic (or outpatient service) was opened at 317 Stockton and operated from 1897-1899. The clinic opened and closed several times before the opening of the Gunst Clinic in 1916 established a permanent outpatient department. The Mount Zion Training School for Nurses was formed in 1897 to provide trained nurses for the hospital.

In 1899 the hospital moved to 2311 Sutter between Scott and Divisadero. This neighborhood would become the hospital's permanent home. With subsequent expansions, it eventually acquired the whole block. This building survived the 1906 San Francisco Earthquake and Fire, though it was briefly evacuated due to fire. However, the building was already inadequate for the increasing patient load and the need to provide outpatient services. The Hellman building named by I.W. Hellman in memory of his wife Esther (he had donated \$100,000 of the \$250,000 capital campaign), opened February 7, 1914 and was billed as "the most modern hospital in San Francisco." Services continued to expand with the opening of the above mentioned Gunst Clinic, the institution of the Social Services Department, an increased patient census, and the inauguration of home care by visiting physicians and nurses.

Both World War I and World War II saw large numbers of Mount Zion doctors and nurses enlisting in military service, increased labor and supply costs, and other labor issues. The end of World War I brought the influenza epidemic which severely taxed both staff and facility. 1916 through the 1920s were a major time of growth and transition, and struggles with rampant inflation. It was also the beginning of specialization in medicine and the solidification of new departments (child welfare clinic, outpatient department, mental hygiene department -- predecessor to the psychiatric department -- and the chest department). The 1930s saw the establishment of Mount Zion as a teaching hospital and community hospital, with a three year nursing program and increased places for interns. The new bylaws emphasized a focus on finding places for Jewish doctors and interns "while not losing sight of the care of the needy Jew." The Harold Brun Cardio-Vascular Research Center was established in 1939 and this trend towards research increased tremendously after the Second World War.

The end of the war again found Mount Zion outgrowing its space with all projections showing continually increasing need. The Hospital had begun acquiring property in 1944 but was unable to begin fundraising until 1947. Construction began in 1948, but unanticipated costs caused delays. The new four story building opened in December 1950, but due to nursing and support staff shortages it was not fully functional. The building was designed for expansion and a 5th and 6th floor were slowly completed over the decade.

Mount Zion Hospital celebrated its 75th anniversary in 1962 with various commemorative events, including a capital campaign drive. That year, the Nursing School, which had incorporated independently as the Mount Zion School of Nursing in 1942, graduated its last class. 1963 saw the opening of the new outpatient building which contained the Claire Zellerbach Saroni Tumor Institute and the Department of Psychiatry.

From 1952 to 1971 Mount Zion had been guided by a strong Administrator, Mark Berke, who worked well with all levels of staff and oversaw the increasing administrative

requirements of departments, the burgeoning of government control and the proliferation of paperwork. His death in 1971 left a vacuum. His replacement, Jay Okun Yedwab (1971-1975), faced labor disputes, fiscal problems and the national malpractice crisis during his tenure, though he also oversaw the needed restructuring of several departments and expansions in oncology, pediatrics, and medicine. In 1975 William Gurtner, a Berke protégé and current Mount Zion employee took over as Administrator. In his decade of service he oversaw a redefinition of focus with cutbacks in training programs and some services. He also oversaw Mount Zion's first formal affiliations with UCSF and various cooperative agreements with other San Francisco hospitals in an attempt to stay competitive in the changing medical world. Medicare, HMOs, increasing costs and new technologies challenged Mount Zion through the 1970s and 1980s. Gurtner's successor Martin Diamond oversaw the final attempt to save Mount Zion Hospital through a merger with the University of California. The UCSF-Mount Zion merger was approved in 1989 with a three year phase in to be completed during the 1992 fiscal year.

The Ladies Auxiliary

The Mount Zion Ladies Auxiliary was founded in 1897 with the opening of the first hospital. Later called the Women's Auxiliary, it dropped the gender designation from its name in the 1970s in order to welcome men into its ranks. The auxiliary at first provided linens, ran the hospital kitchen, and provided other valuable services. Eventually the women's organizing power was recognized: the president of the auxiliary became a voting member of the Board of Directors and auxiliary members were appointed to board committees. Over the years the auxiliary took on a number of different tasks including responsibility for major fundraising campaigns, the training and provision of volunteers in a number of capacities including patient and family services. The auxiliary, at times, ran a gift shop, a coffee shop, and a travel desk.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection contains minutes, bylaws, correspondence, departmental records, reports, financial records, publications, photographs, slides, audio tapes, microfilm, books and memorabilia (including medical instruments, personal and commemorative items) covering Mount Zion Hospital Association and successor institutions from its formation in 1887 up to its merger with the University of California San Francisco in 1992. Except for a few ledgers from the 1910s and 1920s (and a Radiology ledger from the 1940s) this collection does not contain patient records. For more information on Mount Zion, see also the extensive files in the collection of former board president, Rhoda Goldman.

Except for Minutes and Annual Reports which are close to complete, the majority of the materials consist of scattered files from a variety of departments, organizations and offices. The bulk of the material covers the 1960s through the 1980s. Besides Minutes, Bylaws and Annual Reports other series or subseries with earlier material include: Financial Records (scattered), Building and Planning (Hellman Building 1908-1917, and 1940s), Auxiliary (minutes from 1930-1990, some 1950s), Medical Staff (some 1950s), Departments (patient ledgers 1914-1925, 1930s and 1950s), Nursing School (1907-1962), Public Affairs (some clippings 1932-1959), Publications and Pamphlets (some 1950s), and Archives Committee and Objects (scattered items).

Besides documenting the development and demise of a Jewish organization this collection also provides insight into changes in hospital administration, fundraising and philanthropic practices, the development of psychiatry and other medical fields, and other social and historical topics.

Of special interest are the few patient ledgers, materials pertaining to the merger with UCSF, documents showing the evolution of medical care and hospital organization (including the emergence of HMO's, labor disputes, malpractice), and meditations on the meaning of the specifically Jewish nature of Mount Zion. Also included are oral histories with members of the Mount Zion community, publicity and other photographs, extensive clipping files, and a variety of objects. Objects include: medical instruments, a cup used for Bris, eyeglasses belonging to Dr. Julius Rosenstirn, pens, scissors, pins, a variety of plaques, diplomas and certificates and a miniature bottle of commemorative champagne. The collection is divided into 4 major series (Board of Directors, Administration and Finances, Programs and Services, and Pamphlets/Public Affairs /Publications/ Photos). These series are divided into sub-series and some sub-sub series. Arrangement of material depends on the series or subseries and include both chronological, alphabetical and hierarchical schemes. Some material remains in reverse chronological order.

The major subseries are: Board of Directors (Minutes, Bylaws, Annual Reports, General Board Files, Board President Files), Administration and Finance (Administration-Operations, Director's files (Mark Berke), Joint Planning/Mergers, and Health Systems, Inc.), Programs and Services (Archives Committee (including Oral History files), Auxiliary, Geriatric Services, Health Education Pamphlets, Medical Education, Medical Staff, Nursing School, and Tumor Institute), and Public Affairs/Publicity/Publications (Publicity Files, Clippings, Periodicals, Other Publications, and Photographs).

A small amount of material has been restricted for approximately 50 years from creation due to possibly sensitive materials. The opening date is clearly marked in the box list.

CONDITION REPORT

The collection is in generally good condition. Some materials have been damaged (particularly several issues of *Medical Leaves*, have suffered insect damage), there is a large amount of untreated newsprint in the Clippings subseries. Photographs range from excellent to poor condition.

SERIES DESCRIPTION

Series I

BOARD OF DIRECTORS RECORDS, 1887-1990

This series contains the records of the Mount Zion Board of Directors from its founding in 1887 to the merger in 1990. It is divided into 4 major subseries: Minutes, Bylaws, Annual Reports, and Board Files. See also the Rhoda Goldman Papers (2000/07) for records kept by her during her tenure as board president including extensive strategic planning files.

The **Minutes** subseries is the largest in the collection (26 boxes and 7 oversize boxes). The subseries includes multiple overlapping formats (original minute packets, bound minutes (handwritten, typed and printed), and microfilm) and are arranged chronologically within format. Also included in this series are minutes of the Hospital Committee (later the Executive Committee) which were sometimes kept separately and sometimes combined with the Board minutes. The first 7 boxes (minute packets) are legal sized. The three rolls of microfilm are kept in the microfilm cabinet. There are also oversize boxes containing oversize volumes.

The **Bylaws** subseries contains copies of successive versions of the hospital's bylaws from the 1887 bylaws and articles of incorporation to the 1989 version. It also includes a 1907 Certificate of Increase of Board of Directors. Some of these files are legal sized and housed in a separate box at the end of the collection. Bylaws for individual

departments and organizations can also be found in the Administrative Series (Joint Planning/Merger and Health Systems, Inc.) and the Programs and Services Series (Auxiliary, Employees Council and Medical Staff)

Annual Reports include both individual and collected versions of published annual reports from 1900-1985. Gaps occur in the series, since some years reports were not issued and some appear to be missing. Also included are a few "President's Reports," "Interim Reports," and drafts or unpublished reports. There are also two volumes of annual reports from the Federation of Jewish Charities (which include sections on Mount Zion), an individual report from 1916 and collected reports 1910-1915.

The **Board Files** subseries contains committee minutes, special presentation packets, rosters of board members, officers, and committee members, correspondence, reports, and subject files. It also includes a small amount of material relating to three board presidents: Joseph Sloss, Joseph Blumlein, and Marilyn Yolles.

Series II
ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCIAL RECORDS, 1898-1991

This series contains administrative and financial records, including some building and planning documents. It is divided into 5 major subseries: Administration/Operations, Joint Planning/Mergers, Health Systems, Inc., Financial Records, and Building and Planning Files. Except for the Financial and Building/Planning subseries which contain earlier materials most of the documents in this series are post 1950, with the majority from the 1980s and 1990s. For minutes and other materials from the hospital's Management Group (1985-1989) and Administrative Staff Meetings (1988) see Series IV: Public Affairs Department: box 88.

The **Administrative/Operations** subseries (5 boxes) contains a variety materials relating to the administration and operation of the hospital. It is divided into general files and materials relating to long-time administrative director, Mark Berke. The general files include a copy of the 1985 license, accreditation report, a 1963 case study of the hospital by Charles Perrow, Federation of San Francisco Hospitals bylaws, various reports (including one on HMO Formation), articles, forms and stationery, hospital menus, Fact Sheets and correspondence. The Mark Berke materials include biographical information, Berke's annual "Summary of the Year," and correspondence (consisting primarily of memo accompanying articles Berke distributed among the board and/or the staff. The largest amount of materials consists of bound copies of speeches and articles written by Mark Berke (8 volumes 1960-1965).

The **Joint Planning/Mergers** subseries (4 boxes) contains materials from the Joint Program and Planning Board and David Melnick's Mount Zion UCSF Integration files. Except for some background material dating back to the 1950s all the material in this subseries dates from 1984-1991. The Joint Program and Planning Board files (1 box) contains some minutes and board documents, but consists primarily of Bylaws and/or Articles of Incorporation for each of Mount Zion's separate or semi-separate divisions (San Francisco Institute on Aging, Mount Zion Ventures, Mount Zion Auxiliary, Medical

Staff, Community Crises Services of San Francisco, Health Systems Inc., and Mount Zion Hospital Corporation. The remainder of the subseries contains the files kept by David Melnick, during his tenure as the last Chairman of the Board (1988-1992), documenting the steps leading to Mount Zion's merger with UCSF. Documents include Environmental Impact Reports, concerns about specific departments, trusts and special funds, audit, Letters of Intent and publicity.

The **Health Systems, Inc.** subseries (1 box) contains files relating to the establishment of Health Systems, Inc. to carry on aspects of Mount Zion's mission, and manage the hospital's designated donations and trusts, after the merger. File topics include: correspondence, board membership lists, committee information, bylaws, financial, and conflict of interest declarations.

The **Financial** subseries consists primarily of annual financial reports and audited annual accounts, it also includes some budget materials and other financial reports. There is one folder containing incomplete records from 1898-1899, two ledger books from 1906-1920 or 1929, and a few other records from the 1920s and 1930s. More complete records cover 1941-1954 and 1967-1990.

The final subseries, **Building/Planning** contains correspondence, bills and other financial records from 1908-1917 pertaining to expansion needs and the construction of the Hellman building. Also included are materials concerning the 1946-1950 expansion effort (including building campaign pledge cards); 1960s and 1970s building and maintenance committee minutes, and other documents; and 1980s building and facility planning reports ranging from Renal Dialysis to Word Processing and the 1985 "Institutional Master Plan."

Series III

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES RECORDS, 1887-1994

The Programs and Services Series contains information from various departments and programs within Mount Zion Hospital ranging from semi-independent agencies like the Auxiliary and the nursing school to departments such as Psychiatry and Radiology. It also includes information on programs and activities of the hospital that may not be linked directly to a specific department but are connected by purpose or topic (Geriatric/ Aging Services for example). Records for individual departments range from a single folder to many boxes but in no case represent complete records for that department or agency.

The series is arranged alphabetically by program or service but is divided into three categories. The single folder collections are housed first, then the four medium sized collections (Geriatrics/ Aging, Medical Education/ Conferences/ Workshops, Psychiatry, and the Claire Zellerbach Saroni Tumor Institute). The Auxiliary, Archives Committee, Medical Staff and Nursing School each have their own subseries.

Of special note among the single folder materials are two Patient Ledgers (1914-1917 and 1925), a North Wing [Patient] Ledger (1917-1922), an Out Call Register (1914-1917),

a Surgical Ledger (1901- 1913), and the Radiology Log Book (1956-1957). The material on the Child Guidance Clinic consists solely of a financial ledger. The **Geriatrics/Aging** documents range from 1956-1986 and consist primarily of reports and working agreements with the Jewish Home for the Aged. Also included is a copy of *A Resource Guide of Services for Seniors in San Francisco* and one folder on Mount Zion's Alzheimer's Adult Day Health center. **Medical Education/Conferences/Workshops** includes folders pertaining to a variety of continuing education and public conferences and workshops presented by Mount Zion. The **Psychiatry Department** records cover the period from 1976-1981 and include discussions of the future of the department, financial status, department summary and information on some staff members. The **Claire Zellerbach Saroni Tumor Institute** records include correspondence, minutes and press reports from the 1970s. The majority of the Tumor Institute files are **restricted** due to privacy and personnel issues for approximately 50 years from creation. The opening date is January 1, 2029. See archivist for more information.

The **Archives Committee** subseries (7 boxes) contains records pertaining to or collected by the Archives Committee, and the Traditions/Portraits Committee. Committee records include: minutes, memos, correspondence, accession logs and research inquiries. Collected materials consist of a variety of hospital records, objects and ephemera including obituaries, a wedding invitation, diplomas, articles on the "Jewishness" of the hospital and much more. Objects collected include Julius Rosenstirn's eyeglasses, souvenir bottle of champagne, pens used to sign a lease, a 75th Anniversary banner and a collection of medical instruments. A few photographs are found at the end of this series.

Three special projects are detailed: The attempt to publish Dr. Joseph Levitin's manuscript *The Story of A Hospital* (drafts and correspondence), the research and publication of Mount Zion's Centennial Book Project -- *First Century* (correspondence, research materials, drafts, etc.), and the **Oral History** project (transcripts of oral history interviews with doctors, nurses, board members, patients and others, conducted between 1975 and 1994). For a printed version of *First Century* see Publications in Series IV. For taped copies of the oral history interviews see the WJHC Tape Collection.

The largest subseries contains the records of the Mount Zion **Auxiliary** (14 boxes). The Auxiliary records in the collection range from 1930-1990, though the majority of the records are from the 1950s through the 1970s. They are divided into: Minutes/ Administrative, Subject Files, Fundraising, Travel Desk, and Publications. Fairly complete minutes exist for 1930-1988, the **Minutes/Administrative** sub-subseries (3 boxes) also includes bylaw and budget materials and two articles. The **Subject Files** (3 boxes) are arranged alphabetically and include information on the Annual Meeting, volunteer coordination and recognition, publicity, the baby photo service, gift shop and other programs, and committees such as the Cancer Care, Ways and Means, and Legislative Committees. **Fundraising** records (6 boxes) are also arranged alphabetically, by event. Major activities include: auctions in 1978 and 1979, baseball, football, and tennis benefits in the 1960s and 1970s, a series of concerts featuring Arthur Rubinstein, Isaac Stern, Vladimir Ashkenazy and the like, dinner dances, balls and Monte Carlo nights. The Auxiliary **Travel Desk** (19 folders) organized tours to the "Orient," Israel, and Europe, as well as cruises to Panama and other locations from 1966-1982. **Publications** (9 folders) include the *Auxiliary News* (1950-1952), *Memo* (1953-1968,

1978-1984), *Hospital-bly Yours* (1976-1977), and *Chart* (1993). Also included are three reel-to-reel audio tapes: radio ticket sales announcements for a baseball benefit and two copies of a lecture by Kurt O. Schlesinger, M.D. on "Community Relations: Homemaker vs. Worldmaker" from 1964.

The **Medical Staff** subseries (6 boxes) contains materials relating to the Mount Zion medical staff. It consists primarily of successive drafts and revisions of the Medical Staff constitution and bylaws from 1943-1968, and also includes Dental (1968) and Civil Defense Committee (1964-1965) bylaws. Other materials include scattered Mount Zion Board of Directors Minutes referring to medical staff issues, including an item from 1907, committee and credential records. House staff and intern materials include: House Staff Manuals (1947, 1950), Medical Education and House Staff Training information, House Staff Rosters (1965-1975), and Interns' theatrical events including the script for 1958's "The Rise and Fall of Schmucknik." Photographs of interns are found in the House Staff Rosters. The 1975 "**Malpractice Crisis**." (8 folders) documents include: publicity, fact sheets, and other documents. Also included in this subseries are materials relating to **Phi Delta Epsilon**, a medical fraternity, including: Constitution and Bylaws, Correspondence, membership lists, 60th Annual Convention, and Auxiliary materials. There is also a ledger book showing dues and other expenses for 1953-1973.

The final subseries, **Nursing School** records (8 boxes), consists of a variety of materials pertaining to the Mount Zion School of Nursing from 1912 until its closing in 1962. The majority of the collection consists of copies of the nursing school yearbooks, the *NOIZ* (1922-1937) and the *Bib & Apron*(1954-1962). There are no yearbooks for 1924, 1928, and 1938-1953. Other materials include nursing school announcements, pamphlets and recruitment brochures, survey and accreditation materials (1955), Correspondence, nursing school papers and curriculum materials, J.D. Zellerbach commencement address, school publications and other publicity. Objects and memorabilia include nursing school diplomas (1917-1918), 1st reunion commemoratives (1912), school pins, and two embossers with the school seal.

Series IV

PAMPHLETS/PUBLIC AFFAIRS /PUBLICATIONS/ PHOTOS, 1898-1991

The materials in this series all relate to some level of Mount Zion's public relations and publicity functions, including both internal and external relations, internal and external publications, and photographs. The series includes pamphlets, flyers, informational handouts, administrative files and minutes, subject files, clipping files, periodicals, books, photographs, videotapes, and audio tapes. The series is divided into four major subseries: Pamphlets and Informational Handouts, Public Affairs Department, Publications, and Photographs.

The **Pamphlets and Informational Handouts** subseries (3 boxes) is the smallest and contains a variety of materials prepared by a variety of departments concerning hospital policies, services and events. The majority of the items are intended to communicate with hospital patients, but some items are directed at staff or the general public. Of

special note are the Holiday Menus and Holiday Programs, Obstetrics, and Patient Information folders.

The **Public Affairs Department** subseries (32 boxes) covers the years from 1960 to 1990 and contains two main divisions: Administrative and Working Files and Clippings/Reprints. The **Administrative and Working Files** contain: ADMINISTRATIVE FILES (8 folders) which besides extensive correspondence between Marty Diamond, President, and Pat Norman, Public Affairs, [**one folder is restricted and housed with the other restricted files**] also include minutes and other material from Management Group and Administrative Staff meetings attended by Pat Norman; SUBJECT FILES which are arranged alphabetically include materials relating to various public relations and publicity efforts including the promotion of various departments and services (AIDS, Obstetrics, Psychiatry, Radiology, Tumor Institute), awards for public relations efforts (Annual Reports, McGaw Prize), publications (drafts and contracts related to the publication of the cardiology book *Help Yourself to a Healthy Heart*, and various magazines), labor issues (especially the 1988 Local 250/California Nursing Association Strike), the 1989 earthquake, anniversary celebrations and more; PHOTO CONSENTS contain signed permission forms for photographs and interviews of patients for 1982-1988; CONTEST ENTRIES/SCRAPBOOKS are oversize volumes (some disbound) that document specific public relations campaigns [These volumes are in poor condition]; and AUDIO/VISUAL MATERIALS which consist of four VHS video tapes [unviewed] which purport to contain coverage of the 1988 nurses' strike, and 15 audio cassette tapes on various women's health issues, some identified as part of the Healthworks for Women program (see also Publications subseries). **Clippings/Reprints** (19 boxes and 19 oversize boxes or scrapbooks) consists primarily of newspaper clippings collected by the Public Affairs Department most from clipping services. Most of the clippings are arranged chronologically by month for 1972-1989, but some dates are missing, and the 1932-1971 folders contain single articles/reprints or subjects. Occasionally other topics are separated out. Clippings/Reprints also include a number of oversized scrapbooks (some have been disassembled due to extreme deterioration) which cover 1948-1988. Most of these are simply chronological but two volumes are dedicated to coverage of the 1955 Marcus Baby Kidnapping, and one each on the Tay Sachs Prevention Program, Patients Rights/Labor Issues, and the 1988 Nursing Strike.

The **Publications** subseries includes both internal and external publications, as well as some non-Mount Zion books. The subseries is divided into Mount Zion Periodicals (3 boxes, 1 oversize box), Bound Periodicals (4 boxes, 2 oversize boxes), and Other Publications (2 boxes). **Mount Zion Periodicals** and **Bound Periodicals** consist of materials published by Mount Zion Hospital or one of its programs or services. Two copies were retained of each issue if possible, and the bound periodicals may duplicate unbound issues. **Other Publications** include both books by and about Mount Zion: *First Century: Mount Zion Hospital and Medical Center 1887-1987*, books by and about those associated with Mount Zion: *Medical Memoirs: The Reminiscences of William C., Voorsanger, M.D.*, and medical books by Mount Zion affiliated doctors: *A Comprehensive Guide for Cancer Patients and Their Families*, Rosenbaum and Rosenbaum. Also included in this subseries are four volumes of *Medical Leaves* a Jewish Medical Journal, "published under the auspices of the Histadruth," and the histories of two other Jewish connected hospitals, Tuoro Infirmary (New Orleans) and Mount Sinai (Miami). See also the Auxiliary and the Medical Staff Subseries for more publications.

Photographs (27 boxes, 9 oversize boxes, several oversize items, and 1 cardfile box) are the largest sub-series within this series. The majority of the photographs in the collection came as part of the final accession in early 2000. These photographs were reunited with photographs from previous accessions. Material ranges from very poor condition to excellent. The photographs are arranged in two sub-subseries by date, followed by the oversize photographs. The majority of photos mostly dated pre-1980 are arranged alphabetically by subject. This sub-subseries is a streamlining of several inconsistent classification schemes and photographs previously separated from the collection. A smaller run containing photographs from 1983-1990 was kept separate. Further divisions have been made of photographs by size: Oversize⁺ and Oversize⁺⁺. Also included in this sub-series are a few photographic scrapbooks, negatives, and miscellaneous slides. More photographs can be found within other series and subseries. All folders containing photographs should contain the notation [Photos] in the box-list. Negatives can be found both interfiled with the photographs or in separate folders at the end of the subseries.
